On each side of the river grew a tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, with a fresh crop each month. The leaves were used for medicine to heal the nations. 3 No longer will there be a curse upon anything. For the throne of God and of the Lamb will be there, and his servants will worship him.

#### INTRODUCTION

Most of us are familiar with the creation story in Genesis. That story is more than just the explanation of God creating the heavens and the earth. It informs us of the calling God has upon His people. You might say it shows us where we are, whose we are, and where we are headed. In this study we will look into how God commissions us to bring His kingdom into this world as His image bearers, and how we can express that through our lives.

# **STUDY QUESTIONS (45 MIN)**

# **Imaging God**

Q1. Read Genesis 1:27-28: 1 Peter 2:9

In Genesis 1:28, after declaring that man was made in the image and likeness of God, what did God charge Adam and Eve to do? Doing these things gives us an opportunity to represent God to the world. What are some of the terms used to describe us in 1 Peter 2:9, and what is our purpose according to Peter? How do you think the world sees God's image revealed in these actions?

## **Unfolding Creation's Potential**

Q2. Read Genesis 1:31; Romans 8:19-21; Revelation 21:1; 22:1-3 In the Genesis story we find that we are called to be God's representatives on the earth, sharing with Him in its care, nurturing, and the cultivation of its potential. In Romans 8:21 we see that the effects of sin have subjected creation to decay, but in the book of Revelation, how do we see creation as God desires it to be? We have not always done a good job of "unfolding" the potential of the good earth God has charged us to care for. What are some examples of a good potential we have seen developed in this world, and what are

examples of the bad? How do you see the God-aligned desires of our heart making a difference on how we "unfold" the potential of this world?

## **Blessing - Carrying out God's Work**

Q3. Read Acts 1:8

To carry out the work of being God's image bearers, we must show up and engage with the world around us. We can be a blessing in the world by being witnesses to the truth of God in what we do every day. We don't need to run the show, or win the war, but we do need to be a faithful presence in this world. What is one area of this world that you see as "broken" that you would like to see set right? (possibly social issues, cultural issues, or family issues). What would you say is the desire of God's heart for that area of heart-felt concern ("passion")? How are you engaging in that area?

## Q4. Read Colossians 3:23

Each of us has been given a unique opportunity to bless our world by virtue of how God has created us and where He has planted us. What is it that occupies the majority of your day? What attitude does Colossians 3:23 encourage us to have in whatever we do? This may be easier in some cases than others. What is one thing you can do that would help you maintain this perspective throughout your day?

All of us have passions and gifts that we can use for God's kingdom. What would you say is your "gift"? Ask others in your group what they see as your gift. If you were to give God permission to use your gift for His purposes, can you imagine what that might possibly involve? What hinders you from using that gift fully?

### THE BOTTOM LINE

From the beginning, God created us in His image and likeness, and gave us the mission to bear witness of Him to the world. He calls us to care for, nurture, and cultivate its potential. To do this we have to show up and be witnesses to God's truth and goodness. In order to be part of unfolding God's redemptive purposes in our sphere of influence, we use the gifts God has given us, doing our work for the Lord. When we align our heart's desires with God's, we will fulfill our calling and bring a blessing to the world.

### **PUTTING IT INTO PRACTICE**

God has given us work beyond our employment and this would include our broader mission to bear His image in witness to the world. As we journey further into our study, continue the habits and practices that allow God to reshape your heart's desire. As you do, remember to approach God "with your arms wide open", inviting Him in so that he can recalibrate you heart, re-form your desires and adjust your loves to reflect His own. This week ask God to show you a creative and innovative way to use your God-given gifts to set one area of the world to right.
