Sometimes we find ourselves in a dangerous place. Maybe because of our own bad choices, or maybe it just happened, but when you are in danger you can trust that God will come to save you. The Prophet Isaiah told us that in this verse.



In the Bible we read about Joseph, who was thrown down a well by his brothers then sold as a slave and eventually put in prison. For a long time, it didn't look good for Joseph, but he trusted God anyway. And God was able to save him.

DISCUSSION:

When has somebody saved you from a dangerous situation?



After you were safe, did you think that maybe God sent that person to save you?

How many ways can you think of that God could save you if you fell out of a raft and into the river filled with crocodiles?



Find out what trusting feels like by doing the trust experiment with a partner. Talk about how it felt to sit down without being able to see the chair. Do you feel the same way when you trust God even if you can't see Him?

Jesus called himself the good shepherd. Who does Jesus take care of?

KNOWING GOD'S WORD HELPS YOU FIND THE RIGHT PATH





Have you ever taken a "penny walk"?

If not, here is how it works: Start walking down the street until you get to an intersection, then flip a coin- heads go left, tails go right. Continue to use the coin toss to decide if you go left or right every time you get to an intersection.

But you better know the way home because there is no telling where you will end up.

Try using a penny to decide your route through the maze on the next page. When you come to a pair of coins flip the penny to see which way to go. I bet the penny takes you places you didn't want to go to.

Proverbs 3:6 tells us that God will show us which path to take. He has better ways than tossing a penny.
