WHAT IS TRUST?

TRUST - TO BELIEVE IN THE RELIABILITY, TRUTH, ABILITY, OR STRENGTH OF SOMETHING OR SOMEONE.

Look at the picture. Trusting the right person would be very important here. What type of person would you choose to trust to bring you safely through the rapids?

What would happen if you trusted the wrong person?

Sometimes we find ourselves in a dangerous place. Maybe because of our own bad choices, or maybe it just happened, but when you are in danger you can trust that God will come to save you. The Prophet Isaiah told us that in this verse.



See, God has come to save me. I will trust in him and not be afraid. The LORD GOD is my strength and my song; he has given me victory."

1SA1AH 12:2

In the Bible we read about Joseph, who was thrown down a well by his brothers then sold as a slave and eventually put in prison. For a long time, it didn't look good for Joseph, but he trusted God anyway. And God was able to save him.

When has somebody saved you from a dangerous situation?






After you were safe, did you think that maybe God sent that person to save you?

But you better know the way home because there is no telling where you will end up.


