WHAT TO DO EACH DAY

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Read the daily suggested scripture. Spend a few minutes meditating on it. How can you allow God's word to realign your heart towards gratitude today? You may also want to physically write out the scripture in your journal or read the whole chapter for context.

GRATITUDE REFLECTION

Gratitude is a very countercultural habit to posess. In a world that can be cynical or prone to offense and complaining, having a heart full of gratitude feels a bit like protest. Spend some time reflecting on God, his love for you, and the richness of life he's calling you to. Feel free to write down a few things you're grateful for each day or reflect on the best part of your day.

DAY 2 COLOSSIANS 3:14-17

1 CORINTHIANS 1:4-6

I always thank my God for you and for the gracious gifts he has given you, now that you belong to Christ Jesus. Through him, God has enriched your church in every way—with all of your eloquent words and all of your knowledge. This confirms that what I told you about Christ is true.

DAY 3



Since everything God created is good, we should not reject any of it but receive it with thanks. For we know it is made acceptable by the word of God and prayer.



1 THESSALONIANS 5:16-22

Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus. Do not stifle the Holy Spirit. Do not scoff at prophecies, but test everything that is said. Hold on to what is good. Stay away from every kind of evil.





COLOSSIANS 4:2,4-5

Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart.... Live wisely among those who are not believers, and make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be gracious and attractive so that you will have the right response for everyone.



PSALM 28:6-7
