40 DAYS OF PRAYER lent at new life

Over the next 40 days we are believing by faith that God is going to do a miraculous work in each of our hearts as we strip away the distractions of this world and lean into the holy presence of God. We are trusting that the God of revival will set our community on fire as we lead in repentance and

earnestly seek him. We will be using the Lord's prayer as our guide, since Jesus himself used it as a template for how to pray. Each week will be focused on a different phrase from this prayer.

Here's how you can get the most out of the 40 days of prayer:

WORSHIP & FAST ON MONDAYS

Each Monday we are challenging you to fast from sun-up to sun-down (specifically from food, but you can modify it to fit your needs). Then, we will come hungry (physically and spiritually) to meet with the Lord together in worship at 6pm in the Worship Center.

PRAY & JOURNAL EACH DAY

In this journal, you'll find a scripture and a prayer prompt each day. We pray these will lead you into deeper communion with your Father. Lent consists of the 40 days leading up to Easter; however, following tradition, Sundays are not included in these 40 days. That will be reflected in this journal. If you'd like to continue the habit on Sundays, feel free to read and reflect on the longer description of the focus of the week.

SIGN UP FOR DAILY PRAYER TEXTS

We believe there is power in the unity of believers. For that reason we'll be sending out a prayer reminder each day at noon. Text "Prayer" to 805-979-2003 to receive the daily texts.

VISIT THE PRAYER WALK

Feel free to utilize our Prayer Walk space as a location to meet with God. The prayer prompts will also follow along with the Lord's Prayer.

Prayer begins, first and foremost, with an understanding of who you are communing with.

Who is God?

Wow! What a question. Humans have been futilely trying to answer that question since the beginning of their existence.

Who is my Creator? Can he be trusted? What does he think of me?

Obviously, it will take longer than 40 days to ponder these deep inquiries, but our hope is that this journey will draw you closer to the heart of God and give you a deeper understanding of who God is, how much he loves you and wants to shape you more and more into who he created you to be...for the sake of others.

At the heart of prayer, of spending time in the presence of God, is the right understanding of God as your FATHER. When Jesus taught us to pray he didn't begin with,

"Oh, far away cosmic being..." nor with "Hey, bestie...".

No, he told us to pray to "Our FATHER in heaven..."

Because a father is relational.

A father is *near*.

A father has authority.

A father recognizes the needs of his children and provides for them.

A father has *more wisdom* than his children.

I don't know all the ways your earthly father shaped your understanding of what a father is. No matter what, I know that he fell short of exemplifying a father's love, authority, and wisdom. The fact of the matter is you were *LOVED into existence* by a heavenly Father who created you *with intention*, who knows all the facets of what makes you you, who loves you and *calls you GOOD*. He is FOR you. He wants to see you not just sleepwalking and surviving the day-to-days of life...but living...truly LIVING...*fully alive in Him*.





But may all who search for you be filled with joy and gladness in you. May those who love your salvation repeatedly shout, "God is great!" But as for me, I am poor and needy; please hurry to my aid, O God. You are my helper and my savior; O Lord, do not delay.

HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME

While we celebrate and know that God is our Father, we also must hold in tension the truth that our Father is high and lifted up. He is holy and set apart, very unlike us in every way. In the vastness of

the universe and the heavenly realms, there truly is no one like Him.

When the prophet Isaiah came face to face with his Creator his reaction was to declare his own filth and unworthiness and accept his own destruction. If you need to be reminded of God's holiness, read through Isaiah chapter 6 today and allow yourself to be in awe at the imagery of God, set apart on His throne as terrifying, heavenly beings sing out,

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Heaven's Armies!

The whole earth is filled with his glory!"

Our Father is the King and he is worthy of our praise, our devotion, and our reverence. He is LORD and our role is to sumbit to him every day of our lives...not just because he is a trustworthy, good Father, but also because his holiness demands it.

This week we will be praying through a few different names for God.

As you enter into God's presence each day, enter in with humility and reverence. Each name of God represents a distinct aspect of his character and is a new reason to worship him.

Jesus taught us to pray to our Father while also hallowing his name. This means to hold these names as *sacred, divine, and anointed.* While we often receive the benefits of God's great character and nature...that isn't really the point. The point is, his provision, his healing, his peace, and his victory in our lives should lead us unto greater and deeper awe and worship. When God provides for your needs, *bless his name.* When God guides you along right paths, *admire him.* When God restores you to wholeness, *honor his holy character.*
